Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, the United States was engaged in the conflict in Vietnam from 1957 to 1975; and

WHEREAS, more than eight million United States service members were on active duty during this brutal conflict between August 4, 1964 and January 27, 1973; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty-six thousand Montanans selflessly served our nation during the conflict; and

WHEREAS, Native Americans from Montana Tribes also served during this period, bearing the burden of brutal combat; and

WHEREAS, many were wounded, killed, and labeled missing in action, with some missing to this day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of Montana, do hereby proclaim March 29, 2022

WELCOME HOME VIETNAM VETERANS DAY

in Montana in recognition of all Vietnam veterans and their families for their service and sacrifice.
