Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, more than 70 million Americans have a criminal record, including over 2,700 individuals currently incarcerated and 10,000 on probation and parole in Montana; and

WHEREAS, individuals with a criminal history often struggle to find housing, employment, or education, regain voting rights, volunteer in their community, and pay for significant debt that arises as a result of their conviction and incarceration; and

WHEREAS, the number of legal collateral consequences of a criminal conviction exceeds 44,000, with 527 barriers unique to Montana; and

WHEREAS, these barriers can contribute to recidivism, which decreases public safety; and

WHEREAS, the State of Montana is committed to providing incarcerated individuals with more tools to successfully reenter society and the workforce, reducing recidivism and making our communities safer and stronger;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim April 2023

SECOND CHANCE MONTH

in Montana to reduce recidivism and promote safer, stronger communities.
