## *Governor's Proclamation*



*WHEREAS, Montana is committed to an all-of-the-above approach to energy production, from wind, to oil and gas, to solar, to hydropower; and*

*WHEREAS, two-thirds of Montana's power generation fleet is renewable, and in 2022, Montana ranked 10th among states with the largest share of electricity generated from renewables; and*

*WHEREAS, energy efficiency is achieved by using less energy for the same purpose; and*

*WHEREAS, implementing energy efficient practices, such as unplugging devices when not in use, using LED lights, adding insulation to the attic, and installing weather stripping around windows and doors, can reduce energy consumption, support the environment, and lower energy costs for Montanans;*
