WHEREAS, according to Testicular Cancer Awareness Foundation, approximately 9,760 men will be diagnosed in 2024 with testicular cancer in the United States; and,

WHEREAS, if detected early, testicular cancer has a cure rate of 95 percent; and,

WHEREAS, those who are educated about early detection and the importance of monthly self-exams are more likely to survive and have better treatment outcomes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim April 2024

to spread awareness about testicular cancer and recognize those who have been affected by it.
