Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, education and workforce training can change lives, open the door to greater opportunities, and allow Montanans to reach their full, outstanding potential; and

WHEREAS, providing the next generation with a high-quality education and empowering our workforce with the skills they need to thrive are among our greatest responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Department of Labor & Industry administers a Registered Apprenticeship Program, which enables workers to receive paid, supervised, on-the-job training in more than 100 fields across Montana; and

WHEREAS, Montana added more apprenticeships to the program than ever before in 2022; and

WHEREAS, the state of Montana established the Montana Trades Education Credit to provide employers a tax credit for employee education and training;

WHEREAS, the United States is celebrating the importance of Youth Apprenticeships during the week of May 5, 2024;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim May 5-11, 2024
