## Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, Montana's wildland firefighters take on exceedingly dangerous work, preserving millions of acres of private, state, and federal lands that we know and call home; and

WHEREAS, wildland firefighters protect our environment, communities, natural resources, recreation areas, and agriculture industry, each of which is a key part our state's identity; and

WHEREAS, wildland firefighters persevere through extreme conditions for days and even weeks at a time, living and working in the midst of flames, heat, and smoke; and

**WHEREAS**, these heroes continue to respond to the constant demands of severe fire seasons that are increasing across the West; and

**WHEREAS**, Montana wildland firefighters fought fires on more than 115,000 acres under Montana Department of Natural Resources and Conservation protection in 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, without this strong and skilled workforce in Montana, we would not be able to combat the continued threat of wildland fire;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim July 2, 2024
