WHEREAS, workplaces welcoming of the talents of all people, including people with disabilities, are a critical part of our efforts to build community and a strong economy; and

WHEREAS, the State of Montana's theme for this month is "Access to Good Jobs for All," which showcases its support for employment pathways that not only benefit an individual's independence and self-sufficiency, but also the success of the communities and employers who support them; and

WHEREAS, there are about 81,600 Montanans aged 18-64 with disabilities, with 45,000 who are in the labor force and working; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Disability Employment and Transitions Office is actively working to advance the independence and employment of Montanans with disabilities;
