## Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, Fabry Disease is a progressive, destructive, inherited disorder that causes children and adults to experience symptoms that diminish their quality of life and may lead to premature death due to strokes, kidney failure, and heart failure; and

**WHEREAS,** Fabry Disease is caused by deficient activity of the lysosomal enzyme alpha-galactosidase A (GLA), which results in buildup of lipids in the body, causing cell and organ damage; and

WHEREAS, the disease is severely under-diagnosed and many people live without an accurate diagnosis or opportunity for treatment until after irreversible organ damage occurs; and

WHEREAS, newborn screenings and access to the two approved treatments can help identify and treat Fabry Disease; and

**WHEREAS**, health care providers and families should familiarize themselves with the symptoms of Fabry Disease and, if warranted, obtain a GLA gene test that can definitively assess the presence of this treatable disorder;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim April 2025
