Governor's Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Baby Safety Alliance, established in 1962 as the Juvenile Products Manufacturers Association, has advanced product safety for more than 60 years and launched Baby Safety Month in 1991 to raise awareness about safe practices for infants and children; and

WHEREAS, Montana families, organizations, and leaders join in observing Baby Safety Month each September as an opportunity to promote safety at home, in child care settings, and throughout our communities;
