Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, critical infrastructure, such as financial services, educational institutions, energy, telecommunications, transportation, utilities, health care, and emergency response systems, is increasingly reliant on the support of information systems and technology; and

WHEREAS, cybersecurity education and awareness are crucial for small businesses, financial institutions, schools, government agencies, the home user, and anyone who connects to the internet, whether it be through a computer, mobile phone, or other internet-connected device; and

WHEREAS, maintaining cybersecurity is a shared responsibility, and awareness of good cybersecurity will protect Montana's information, infrastructure, and economy; and

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework is a free resource to help organizations improve their cybersecurity practices; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Information Security Advisory Council (MT-ISAC) was established in June of 2015 to enhance and protect the State of Montana's cybersecurity ecosystem;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim October 2025
