Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, domestic violence impacts Montanans of all backgrounds; and

WHEREAS, everyone knows someone who has been affected by domestic violence or domestic violence-related offenses; and

WHEREAS, 1 in 4 women and 1 in 7 men experience domestic violence nationally each year, and children who grow up in violent homes are believed to be abused and neglected at a rate higher than the national average; and

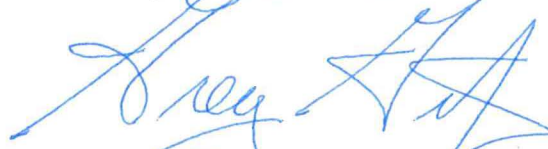
WHEREAS, Montana law enforcement officers respond to a domestic violence call or domestic violence related call every 1.95 hours; and

WHEREAS, Montanans can help reduce domestic violence through prevention education and increased awareness and ensuring justice for victims of violence by holding perpetrators responsible for their actions;
