Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, the United States was engaged in the conflict in Vietnam from 1957 to 1975; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty-six thousand Montanans selflessly served our nation during the conflict; and

WHEREAS, Native Americans from Montana also served during this period, sharing the burden of brutal combat; and

WHEREAS, many United States service members were tragically wounded, killed, or labeled missing in action, with some missing to this day; and

WHEREAS, Montana is proudly home to nearly thirty thousand veterans who served in the Vietnam War;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim March 29, 2026

WELCOME HOME VIETNAM VETERANS DAY

in Montana to honor Vietnam veterans for their service to our nation and instill in the next generation gratitude and respect for those who serve our country.
