Governor's Proclamation



WHEREAS, it is essential that Montanans of all ages and backgrounds be financially literate, responsible, and able to properly manage money and investments; and

WHEREAS, many people have difficulty managing finances due to a lack of financial education; and

WHEREAS, increasing the financial knowledge of Montanans can help improve the quality of their lives, develop skills for success, as well as strengthen the economy; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Board of Public Education added financial literacy or economics to high school graduation requirements, ensuring students graduate with demonstrated knowledge about earning an income, good spending habits, saving, investing, and managing risk; and

WHEREAS, Montana strengthened its laws to affirm the expectation that students in K-12 public schools receive instruction in financial literacy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Greg Gianforte, Governor of the State of Montana, do hereby proclaim April 2026

FINANCIAL LITERACY MONTH

in Montana to recognize the important role that financial literacy plays in empowering Montanans to thrive in their community.
