#### **Subcommittee Recommendation Template**

Subcommittee Name: Local Government

#### **Recommendation:**

Require new voter approved levies to receive a 60% affirmative vote to be passed.

#### **Rationale:**

Voter approved levies constitute a significant portion of property tax increases. Making it more difficult to pass these levies will reduce future growth in property taxes.

#### **Barriers Addressed:**

Future growth in residential property taxes is directly tied to any new voter approved mill levies. This will reduce the future growth of mill levies.

## **Key Strategies:**

The state legislature should consider requiring more than a simple majority for passage of new budget authority.

## **Dissenting Opinions (if applicable):**

Mill levy elections are already challenging to pass and further increasing the barriers to passage doesn't give voters sufficient control of their local government budget choices.
